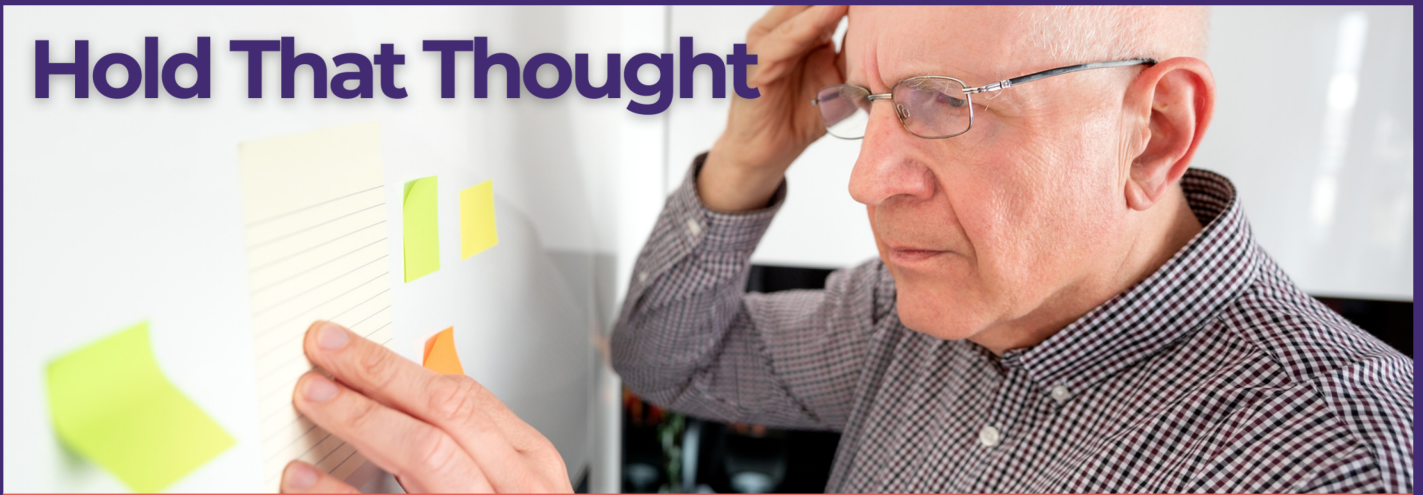


Hold That Thought
